Italian-German Strategic Dialogue - Second Edition

The Italian-German Strategic Dialogue, co-organised by the Istituto Affari Internazionali and the Stiftung Wissenschaft und Politik, in collaboration with the Hanns Seidel Stiftung, follows on from the annual 'Italian-German Strategic Forum on Europe', originally initiated in 2016. Traditionally, the Strategic Dialogue focuses on bilateral issues between Italy and Germany, as well as on critical EU topics. This recurring meeting is featured as a closed event for selected experts from government institutions, business community and think-tanks from Germany and Italy, held alternately in Berlin and Rome. This year, the debate will address the topics of italian-german economic security in the European dimension, and the latest developments in defence cooperation between the two countries. In both areas, the two countries have a long history of successful cooperation and a considerable potential for further development. A few months after the signature of the ambitious German-Italian Action Plan of November 2023, intended to intensify cooperation between Rome and Berlin in the face of the current Geopolitical challenges, this event aims at exploring two strategic sectors at the core of the agreement between the two countries.
